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SUMMARY	Eduardo G Pereira has been active in the natural resources and energy industry for more than 15 years and is an international expert on oil and gas contracts and regulations. He has oil and gas practical experience in over 50 jurisdictions covering America, Europe, Africa and Asia. Dr. Pereira concluded his doctoral thesis on oil and gas joint ventures at the University of Aberdeen (Scotland). He conducted postdoctoral research at Oxford Institute for Energy Studies (University of Oxford, UK), another postdoctoral research at the Scandinavian Institute of Maritime Law (University of Oslo, Norway) and more recently at the Institute of Energy and Environment (University of São Paulo, Brazil). He holds full-time, part-time, honorary, adjunct and visiting positions in several academic institutions. He is also a managing editor for the GSENRLJ and an associate editor of <i>OGEL</i> . He is also the author and editor of several leading oil and gas textbooks.
